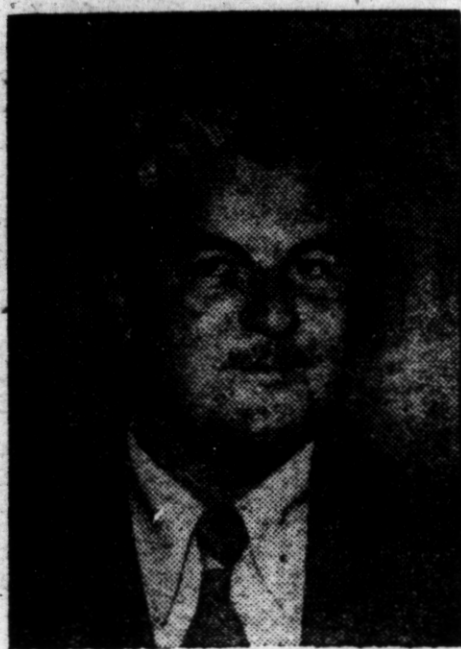
Leaders of Communist Party Urge United Support to DW Fund Drive
